Position Open To:

Volunteer positions are open to anyone over the age of 16, or 14 with parental consent. Members of visible minority groups, Indigenous people, persons with disabilities, LGBQ+ persons, trans and gender-variant persons, ESL individuals and new-comers, and others with the skills and knowledge to engage productively with diverse communities are encouraged to apply.

Major Responsibilities:

- Follow Health and Safety Protocols
- Store Functionality Assist with distributing new stock to shelves and racks, assist with stock rotation of older items, sort/organize stock (by colour, size, likeness, etc.)
- Store Maintenance Dust shelves, sweep floors, straighten clothing and general stock
- Stock Preparation Assist preparing stock for sale, such as tagging clothing
- Store Sanitization Assist with tasks relating to COVID-19 cleaning needs
- Customer Service Greet customers, help customers find items, bag purchases.
- Sorting and Prepping Donations Assist with the receiving and processing of donations
- Hanging and Tagging Clothing Assist with the preparing of clothing for sale
- Cashier Optional role as cashier to relieve staff for breaks

Skills and Abilities required:

- Respect for all individuals regardless of race, nationality, gender, sexuality, class, ability, or religion
- Demonstrates interpersonal skills

- Works well in a team
- Ability to give and receive feedback
- Ability to follow direction

- Ability to stand for long periods
- Merchandising experience is an asset
- Desire to develop communication skills (ESL)
- Attention to detail

Working Conditions:

• Indoors, overhead lighting, temperature regulated, medium to low noise levels including background music, some natural light, onsite break room and washroom available.

Physical Accessibility:

• Wheelchair accessible entrance, working area, washroom and break room.

Training Provided:

 Overview of WIN Co-op with Community Liaison Coordinator, take-home orientation package, and onsite one-on-one training with a designated supervisor such as daily tasks, goals, health and safety including communicable Disease Prevention plan and COVID-19 protocols, site orientation.
